

Enrichment

Catholic schools enrich *spirit* with God's Word and service to His people, *mind* with faith-based academics and *body* with healthy habits.

Spiritual enrichment includes daily prayer, attendance and participation in Mass as readers, greeters and servers and assistance in Christian Service projects throughout the school year. Past service has included visiting and presenting a program to senior citizens, assisting in the St. Mary's Pregnancy Center, God's Kitchen and Flat River Outreach. Challenge, a girl's club, welcomes members. With the help of teachers and volunteer costumers and directors, students prepare a Christmas Nativity program and Passion of Christ Easter program each year.

Academic enrichment includes Writer's Workshop, Accelerated Reader, Art, Physical Education, Music and Spanish classes. Additionally, there is opportunity to participate in Odyssey of the Mind (K-6) and Science Olympiad (7-8), both of which encourage students to stretch their minds and work together creatively and cooperatively.

Social skills and healthy habits are reinforced by the Middle School Athletic Program (GRACEAC); 10-100-1000 Summer Club which encourages logging time spent in prayer, reading and activity; Mileage Club, a lunchtime walking program; and Field Day. Student Council provides service projects and leadership opportunities for students.
